

What is MND?

Motor Neurone Disease is a devastating terminal condition with no known cause or cure that takes away a person's ability to move, speak, swallow, and eventually breathe.

If you have MND, the motor neurones that carry messages from the brain to your muscles become damaged and die. When this happens, the muscles they support weaken and waste away

On average, two Australians are diagnosed with, and two die from MND each day, and roughly 14 lives are forever changed by each diagnosis.



How you make a difference

MND Queensland is the only Australian State Association that doesn't receive ongoing State Government funding. Queenslanders over 65 who are living with MND are ineligible for NDIS funding. A My Aged Care funding package for those over 65 is woefully inadequate to support someone with MND in comparison.


"The likelihood that your My Aged Care Package will get approved before you die is very slim. My mother was certainly one of those who knew that she was going to need one but never got it." - Penny
